Completion: *Late 2024*

Scope: *Consists of civil drainage, installations of GPT's, installation of four grease arrestors, supply and installation of a 30,000 litre sewer pump out station. All services including trade waste to service Woolworths and multiple specialty retail shops.*

- **Boarding Housing, Randwick**

Contract Value: *\$700,000*

Completion: *Late 2024*

Scope: *Multi-level residential boarding house consisting of 70 units. Drainage, rough ins, provisions of sewer and water connections.*

- **15 Orion Road, Lanecove - 8 level amenities upgrade**

Contract Value: *\$75,000*

Completion: *Late 2023*

Scope: *Disconnections to existing amenities, new rough-ins, drainage upgrades and fit off with the supply of PC items. This multi level upgrade consisted of technical timing and working within live tenancies to hand over these levels at different stages.*



- **15 Orchard Road, Brookvale - Industrial warehouse refurbishment with new amenities to all offices and warehouse spaces**

Contract Value: *\$150,000*

Completion: *2023*

Scope: *This existing warehouse was divided into multiple tenancies. This project included concrete cutting, new drainage, rough in water and fit out. This property required gas. Profect Plumbing co-ordinated with Jemena Gas and Zinfra Meter Centre for the installation of path valve to meter bars for each tenancies.*

Scope: *This project consists of large office amenities and installation of specially designed equipment, being the first of its kind in Australia. We were involved in the process of design through to construction of the processing equipment, in order to ensure its functionality.*

Scope: *A new amenities block was required at the existing site in Horsley Park to service the growing centre. This project consisted of civil stormwater, mains water, new sewer services for male/female and ambulant bathrooms, a horse wash wet area and a commercial solar hot water plant.*

Scope: *As a RISI accredited company and working for Downer Group on the amenities upgrade, we were required to complete new aerial drainage above the train platform. This involved putting systems in place to create a safe work area within a public environment and ensure the train network was not disrupted.*

- **Ausgrid Depot, Dee Why and Potts Hill**

Completion: 2023

Scope: *At Dee Why, the project involved the relocation and upgrade of the fire services and stormwater service for the new materials handling bay. Works included cutting and reinstating of bitumen for the installation of new plumbing services. At Potts Hill, the project involved concrete cutting, trenching and reinstatement for the installation of a new kitchenette.*

- **McCarthy College, Emu Plains**
